**IV. PERSONAL STATEMENT**

**V. ON-CAMPUS HOUSING REQUIREMENT**

All undergraduate, full-time students (those enrolled in 12 or more semester credit hours) with fewer than 24 earned semester credit hours are required to reside in a University-operated residence hall.
