## Eligibility To Earn 3 Credit Hours That May be Applied to the MEd in Educational Technology Leadership or the MEd in Educational Administration Through Credit by Exam

Individuals who successfully complete the course <u>Using Social Media Tools:</u> <u>Educational Communication</u> and earn a minimum grade of 70% on the final comprehensive examination will be eligible to receive academic credit for the course. In order to take the examination and receive the credit, all of the following conditions must be met:

- 1. The student must participate in the entire course at the designated times and dates.
- 2. The student must complete all self-assessments with a minimum grade of 80% and earn all badges.
  - 1. The student must not have been enrolled in any other Lamar University course in the 12 month period preceding the start of the MOOC.
  - 2. The student must take the comprehensive final examination within 7 days of the last day of the five-week course.

The examination must be taken online using a web-based proctoring service (ProctorU).

The proctoring service requires payment of a fee (between \$17.50 and \$26.50, depending on the exam date you select).

- 3. The student must successfully apply and be accepted into the MEd in Educational Technology Leadership or the MEd in Educational Administration program within three (3) months of taking and passing the proctored exam.
- 4. The student must complete all other Lamar University admission requirements as detailed at <a href="http://degree.lamar.edu/admissions.aspx">http://degree.lamar.edu/admissions.aspx</a>

Once the student has completed steps 1-4 above, the student must request the course credit through their advisor. Once the paperwork is completed, the student must pay a \$25 processing fee for the Credit by Exam to be posted onto his or her student transcript. Credit will be posted after the student successfully completes 3 graduate hours.
